A chance to meet **Dr Jane Strachan** - a climate scientist
and **Dr Suzie Imber** - a space scientist

JANE STRACHAN

Jane is a climate scientist and works for the Met Office. She uses instruments like thermometers, rain gauges (which measure how much rain falls) and anemometers (which measure wind) to find out what the weather is like all over the globe. She also uses measuring instruments on satellites which orbit the Earth. The information she collects can help people growing crops in parts of Africa and Asia to be better prepared for changes in the weather. Jane doesn't only look at the weather of the Earth, but also investigates 'space weather' as this can affect how well our phones, TVs and the internet work.

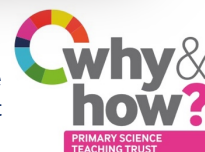


SUZIE IMBER

Suzie is a space physicist at the University of Leicester. She specialises in studying space weather and is one of the scientists involved in sending measuring instruments on board a spacecraft to Mercury – it is due to arrive there in 2025! Suzie was the winner of the TV series, 'Astronauts: Do You Have What it Takes?' She endured challenges such as taking her own blood, speaking Russian while spinning round very fast, and carrying out emergency procedures on the NASA undersea astronaut training facility. Suzie also loves exploring new regions of our planet, including climbing mountains that have never been climbed before.
