This template features blank domino tiles that can be easily photocopied for use at home or in the classroom.

How to Use:

- **Print:** Make as many copies as you need.
- **Draw:** Use markers, crayons, or pens to draw dots on the dominoes.
- **Cut:** Carefully cut out the individual domino tiles.

Domino Ideas

Tips for Parents

- **Lamination:** For durability, consider laminating the dominoes after they are colored and cut.
- **Theme It:** Encourage children to draw themes relevant to their interests (e.g., animals, space, vehicles).
- **Collaborative Play:** Play the games with your children to model turn-taking and sportsmanship.
- **Customization:** Adapt the complexity based on your child's age and skill level.

Blank Domino Grid

1. **Print/Draw** this template on sturdy paper or card for best results.
2. **Carefully cut** along the outer edges of each domino tile.
3. **Cut along** the center dividing line of each tile.
4. **Decorate or use** as needed for your game or activity. Remember to make two ends of the dominoes with the same content so that they match up.



Next Steps

- **Print and Cut:** Download and print the template, then carefully cut out the dominoes.
- **Decorate:** Get creative and decorate your dominoes with markers, paint, or stickers.
- **Play:** Use your custom dominoes for a game night or educational activity.
