How to setup the board

- Add words, sounds or sums to each square
- Each player needs a counter (it can be coin or a button).
- You need a die, or alternatively you can use a number generator on your phone, but only let it use numbers 1 to 6.

Tips for Parents

- You can print out this board or make one on the inside of a cereal box or other large piece of cardboard.
- Making the board can sometimes be as much fun as playing it.
- Remember to put more ladders at the bottom and more snakes near the top.

Rules

- Everyone's counter starts on square 1.
- Roll the die and move that many spaces.
- Read the word/sound/sum that you land on. If you get it right you stay there if not go back to where you were.
- If you land on the bottom of a ladder and answer correctly you can move up the ladder.
- If you land on the top of a snake and answer correctly you do not need to go down it.
- The winner is the first one to get to square 54.
