

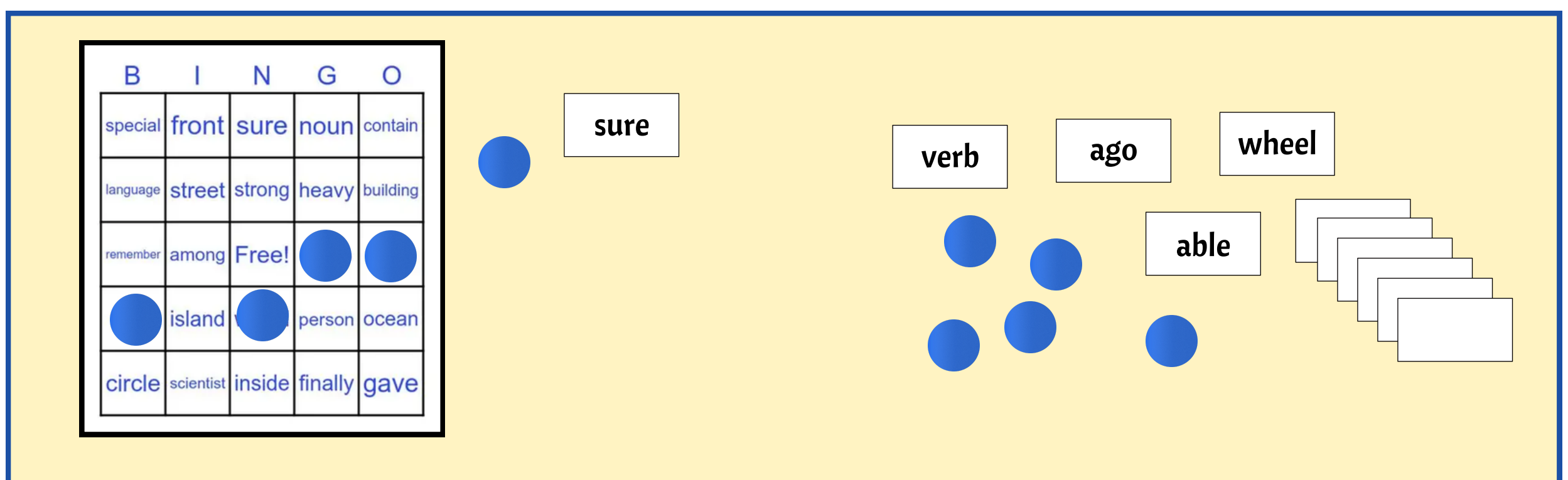
Blank Bingo Board



Bingo can be used to learn many different subjects - times tables, French vocabulary, scientific term, colours, capital cities... Here is how to create your own game.

How to make the bingo board

- Print/copy the board as needed for home use.
- Choose one thing what you want to focus on - shapes, numbers, dots, sight words or sounds.
- Write a different word/number/etc in each box.
- Make sure everyone's bingo board is a bit different.
- Make a set of answer cards. Each card should have one word/picture/etc from the board. Each different item on the board should have a card (i.e. only one of each thing). If you are making a more challenging game the cards can have questions on them with the answers on the board.



How to play

- One player picks a card and reads it out or shows it to the other players.
- If you have it on your board, mark it (cross, counter, sticker, ...).
- Keep listening and marking your board as more cards are called.
- When you get a full row or column shout "Bingo!"
- The items marked on the board are checked against the cards that have been shown.
- They are the first winner.
- You can keep playing until the full board is filled in.
- The winner is checked - then start again!
