Please can we remind parents that when dropping off pupils in the morning an adult needs to accompany children **to the school gates**. We have an increasing number of children who are being dropped off by car on Virgil Street and are walking into school by themselves. This is not safe and although staff are on duty at the gate, they are not responsible for the pupils until they enter school site.

From January 2026 the school gates on Virgil Street and the classroom/external doors will close at **8.55 a.m. prompt** so that pupils and staff can be in the building for the start of the school day. Anyone arriving after this time will need to use the main entrance on Sloper Road.
