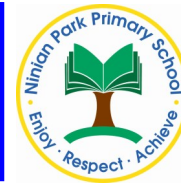




# Ninian Park Primary School Newsletter

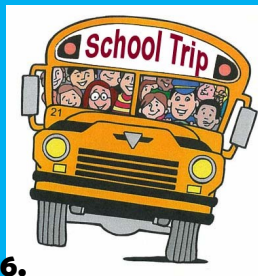
