We have more exciting learning and experiences for your children in the Spring term and we look forward to seeing you at these events too.

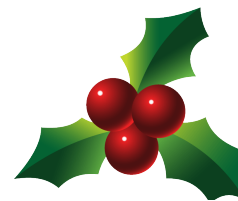
