<p>Learn a Greeting</p> <p>Research how to say “hello” and “thank you” in the language of your chosen country. Write a short paragraph introducing yourself as if you were visiting there.</p>	<p>Travel Budget Challenge</p> <p>Imagine you are visiting your chosen country. Find out the cost of three things (e.g., a meal, a museum ticket, a bus ride). Add them up and convert the total into pounds.</p>	<p>Natural Wonders</p> <p>Research a natural feature from your chosen country (a mountain, river, rainforest, desert). Create a labelled diagram explaining how it was formed.</p>
<p>Create a Cultural Symbol</p> <p>Design a piece of artwork inspired by a country of your choice. It could be a flag, a traditional pattern, a famous landmark, or a national costume. Explain why this symbol represents that country.</p>	<p>Compare Two Countries</p> <p>Choose two countries and create a mini fact-file comparing their climate, food, traditions, and famous places. What makes each one unique?</p>	<p>Food From Around the World</p> <p>Find a traditional dish from your chosen country. Draw it or make it with an adult. Write about the ingredients and why it is important to that culture.</p>
<p>Music Around the World</p> <p>Listen to a piece of traditional music from your chosen country. Describe how it makes you feel and what instruments you think you can hear.</p>	<p>Map It</p> <p>Draw a simple map of your chosen country. Include the capital city, one major landmark, and one physical feature (mountain, river, lake).</p>	<p>Interview at Home</p> <p>Interview a family member about a country they have visited or would like to visit. Write down their answers and explain what makes that country special to them.</p>
